

# Participation and procedure

- Requires an LHV investment agreement.
   Can be subscribed only in LHV's internet bank (including using an Estonian pension investment account).
- Can be bought and sold daily. Clients' accounts will be credited with funds within five days of a transaction
- The unit value (NAV) is published daily.
   Interest income is included in the unit value and re-invested into new bonds
